- If you misplace the forms for the book reports, you can find them on the school website.

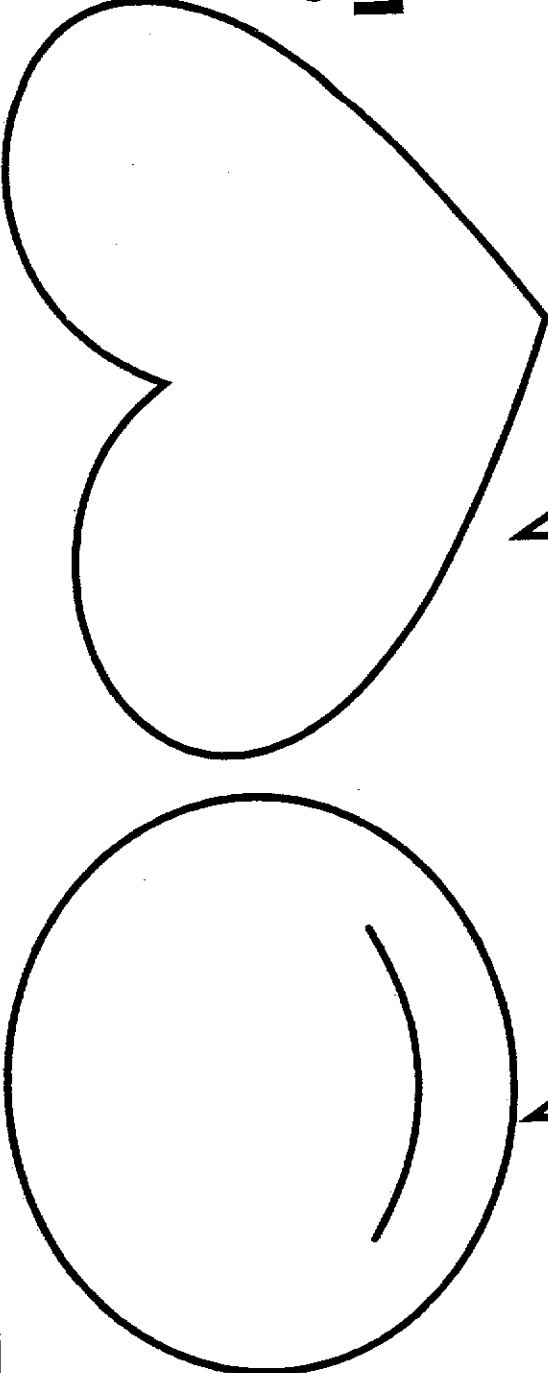

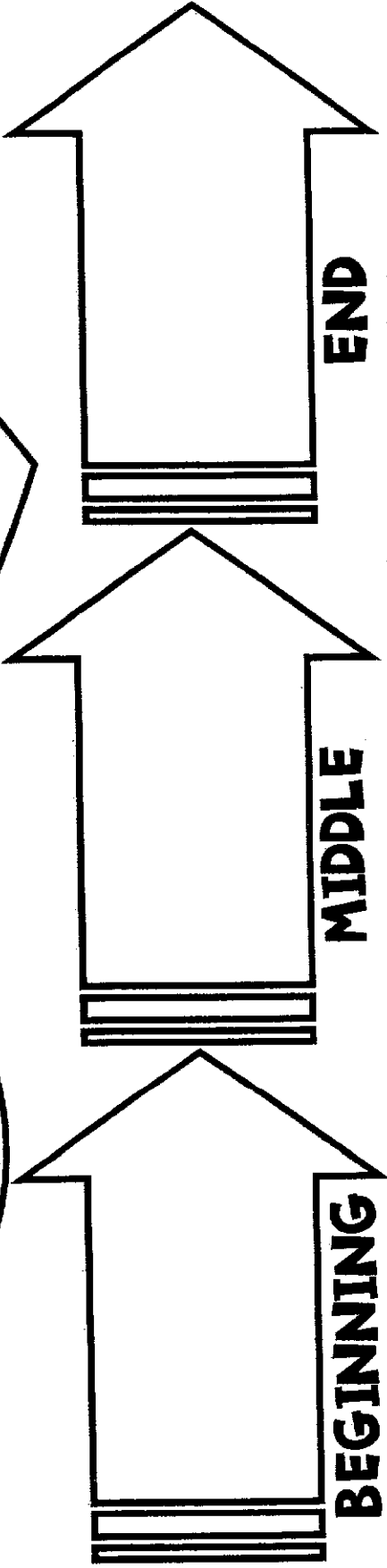
